Family Involvement

Family involvement in schools covers a very broad range of school activities. Most of these opportunities occur DURING THE SCHOOL DAY! Anytime you are involved with your child's academic progress, you are modeling family involvement. Anytime you are in the school, you are modeling family involvement. Family involvement is more than volunteering or being a member of PTO. Making sure your child is in school and ready to learn is family involvement.

This year, the Superintendent of Pasco County Schools has made improving student attendance a high priority for the individual schools. We understand your child will need to be absent a day or two. When sick, they will need to stay home to rest and get healthy. Sometimes dentist/doctor appointments cannot be avoided causing a tardy or early dismissal. These should be occasional occurrences. To be considered excessive, a student would have more than 5 absences/tardy/early dismissals a quarter. Tardiness and early dismissals also affect more than just your child. Teachers must stop instruction to give tardy students directions, which interferes with all students learning. Early dismissals also interrupt learning as the teacher is pulled from teaching to dismiss the student.
