Safer, Smarter, Kids (SSK)

Safer, Smarter, Kids is our school wide guidance curriculum. The curriculum is a prevention curriculum ensured to educate students on their own personal safety and safety in the community.

The School Counselors are going into each classroom monthly to cover the developmentally appropriate prevention curriculum. This curriculum is taught over a series of lessons, in class activities, and videos.

Some of the topics that are being covered include body boundaries, respecting themselves and others, using their voice to tell a trusted adult in the Safety Network when a situation makes them feel confused or uncomfortable.
