You have the right to know the professional qualifications of the educators who instruct your child. Federal law allows you to obtain certain information in a timely manner about your child's classroom teachers and instructional assistants/paraprofessionals. You have the right to ask for the following information about each of our child's teachers and instructional assistants/paraprofessionals:

- 1. The teacher's Florida certification area(s), if the teacher is teaching infield, and if the teacher is gualified infield according to the District School Board of Pasco County.
- The teacher's college degree(s) and areas of study. 2.
- 3. The teacher's advanced college degree(s) and areas of study.
- 4. The gualifications of any instructional assistant/paraprofessionals who provide services to your child.

Cypress Elementary Out of Field Teaching Assignments October 2, 2017

Individuals who are teaching out-of-field are certified in at least one area and are gualified to teach but are required to take additional course work or testing to add a coverage/endorsement to their certificate. The state also requires a teacher to take coursework/in-service towards an English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) endorsement, when the teacher is the primary language provider and/or reading teacher for an ESOL student.
