High Impact Instruction - Teachers will plan, deliver, assess and monitor standards-based instruction matched to the rigor of the standards in all content areas.

- Goal
- Within PLCs and PST, teams will collaborate to determine and <u>monitor</u> essential learnings, common formative assessments, facilitation grids, exit tickets and writing samples.
- Lessons in ALL content areas will require students to produce textual evidence and explain their learning in writing.
- Teachers will work with support staff to build a multi-tiered system of support/instruction to ensure that 80% of students will show one-two years growth in reading as evidenced in IRLA, Comprehension Checks, CFAs, Quarterly Assessments and FSA
- Teachers will cognitively engage students, with students being the center of learning in the classroom through conversational talk.

- Progress of interventions will be monitored, graphed and organized in the team data binder.
- Teachers create and plan interventions tied to essential standards.
